2024 Scholarship Contract

Please carefully read the following information, and if you agree to the terms stated; sign, date, and return to the above address postmarked by June 15, 2024. This contract acts as a binding agreement by the said recipient before any scholarship funds will be issued. *If the contract is not returned by June 15, 2024, the recipient understands that all scholarship funds will be revoked.*

- 1. Scholars are required to maintain contact with Bellville FFA Alumni. In order for us to effectively correspond with you regarding your scholarship, it is imperative we have updated contact information. Scholars are responsible for keeping the alumni informed of any changes of all contact information including, permanent and school address, phone number, and email address.
- After you register for your first semester of college for the Fall 2024semester, submit a copy of the Fall schedule to the above address or email them to *bellvilleffaalumni@gmail.com*. This is your proof of enrollment for the Fall 2024 semester, and should be submitted by email or postmarked by September 1, 2024. Upon receipt of the documentation requested, your first installment will be submitted to you.
- 3. Scholarship funds will be submitted to you in four equal installments provided you have met and followed the guidelines set forth in this document. For Technical Schools with three complete semesters in one year, payment will follow after each semester is complete.
- 4. Upon the completion of the first semester and each semester thereafter as long as a balance of funds exists, you must submit a copy of your grades (official or unofficial transcript) (By January 15th For Fall Semester and June 15th For Spring Semester) to show proof that you have maintained a semester GPA of 2.0 or greater and the minimum 12.0 earned hrs. per semester required. Scholar's name and name of college or university must be visible on the transcript. In addition, you must submit a copy of your next semester's schedule with Scholar's name and the name of college or university clearly visible showing Scholar is registered for a minimum of 12.0 hours before you will receive your next payment. This must be a computer generated copy (no screen shots from computer or phone will be accepted). For Technical Schools with three complete semesters in one year, grades/transcripts should be submitted after each semester is complete.

- 5. <u>In the event that a scholar's semester average falls below the 2.0 GPA or a minimum of 12.0 earned hours required:</u>
 - A. You will be placed on scholastic probation for the following Fall or Spring semester and, the installment of scholarship funds for the scholastic probationary period will be suspended.
 - B. Upon successful completion of the probationary semester, (minimum of 12.0 semester hours & 2.0 GPA or greater), you will then be able to continue receiving any remaining installments of scholarship funds available to you.
 - C. In the event that a student has a combination of two semesters of less than 12 hours or a GPA of less than 2.0, then all remaining scholarship funds will be revoked.
- 6. In the event that the applicant does not submit a required copy of their transcript for a required semester by the dates in #4 above, all remaining scholarship funds will be revoked.
- 7. In the event that the applicant earns an endowment or scholarship that covers all college expenses, the Bellville FFA Alumni respectfully asks that the applicant consider relinquishing the funds of this scholarship back to the BFFAA Scholarship Fund.
